Subsidised School Milk

..... continues to be available at your School during mid-morning break!

Drinking a 1/3rd pint of milk each day at school will provide your child with a whole host of vitamins and minerals as well as about 50% of your child's daily calcium requirement.

Due to the fantastic response, EU subsidised school milk at a cost of 14p per 1/3rd pint carton is available. The school milk scheme will start on Monday, 13 September and will operate on a **termly** basis.

Autumn Term: Monday 13 September to Friday 17 December 2010

Total payable for term = 65 days x 14p = £9.10

Please complete the **Milk Order Form** at the bottom of this letter, if you wish your child to have milk on a daily basis, and return to school with **full payment of £9.10 by this Thursday, 9 September. Unfortunately, refunds can not be made in instances of absence during the term.** Please also ensure that your child knows that milk has been ordered for her / him.
