Howley Grange School Bank

Howley Grange Primary School will be opening a school bank through HSBC and children in Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 are invited to open a savings account. The opportunity to save money encourages children to handle money and begin their lifelong journey to becoming financially responsible.

Teams of current Year 5 and 6 children will work alongside a HSBC employee to collect any monies and fill in record books. Cash and cheques can be paid into a HSBC savings account, although money cannot be withdrawn at school – pupils will need to visit a HSBC branch to make a withdrawal. At age 11, children will also have a current account with a cash machine withdrawal card.

If you are interested in your child opening a HSBC savings account, please complete the tear off slip below and return it to school. A HSBC bank account form will then be sent home for you to fill in with your child. The completed form will need to be returned to school, along with any money to save, on the launch date which is Wednesday 9 November (and only on this date).

I hope that you will encourage your child to open an account and start the journey to achieve economic well-being in the future.
